NATIONAL ENDOWMENT FUND SCHOLARSHIP FORM

The amount of the bursary may vary according to the number of applicants in any given year.

Number: variable, according to the interest generated by the Fund

Value: variable, depending on tuition fees of the post-secondary institution, to a maximum of \$3,000

Eligibility criteria:

- Be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident or have protected person or refugee status;
- Be a victim, spouse or child of a victim of the tainted blood tragedy in Canada occurring between 1980 and 1989 inclusively;
- · Be enrolled (full-time or part-time) in a postsecondary program in a recognized Canadian institution;
- · Have a good academic standing and demonstrate financial need.

Only applications duly completed and accompanied by supporting documents will be processed. When applying, include the following documents:

The application form;

An official transcript including your most recent year of completed studies;

An official proof of enrolment for the upcoming academic year from your postsecondary institution;

A written confirmation from your doctor or an authority who can confirm your status as a victim or as the child of a victim of the tainted blood tragedy in Canada, which occurred between 1980 and 1989 inclusively (if not already provided);

A letter explaining your current financial situation;

A void cheque or direct deposit slip.

Fill out the attached application form, and include your official transcript, a letter of explanation, confirmation of enrolment, direct deposit slip or void cheque, as well as confirmation of your eligibility signed by an authorized medical authority.

Return the application to the Director of the Financial Aid and Awards Service at the University of Ottawa.
